SCOPE

The Talent Development Coach for Canoe Sprint will implement and oversee Canoeing Ireland's National Talent Development Plan as outlined in Canoeing Ireland's HP Strategy; *Pathway to Performance – Paris 2024 and Beyond.*

The Talent Development Coach will provide a high level of effective leadership and coaching. They will contribute to the day to day development of athletes and coaches at club and national level. All activity should contribute to Canoeing Ireland's Talent objectives, outcomes and measures as stated in our HP strategic document.

KEY ACCOUNTABILITIES

- 1) Uphold, advocate and comply with Canoeing Ireland's values and behaviours.
- 2) Provide effective and professional coaching service to athletes and club development coaches.



- Oversee Talent Development activity to ensure development athletes and coaches receive the highest quality experience.
- 4) Support the HP Director and work to achieve agreed performance goals and targets.
- 5) Proactively manage and develop all aspects of the Talent Development Programme and report regularly to the Canoeing Ireland Performance Director.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES and DELIVERABLES

- 1) Uphold the vision and mission of Canoeing Ireland High Performance.
- 2) Be the first point of contact for Canoeing Ireland Talent Pathway coaching enquiries and correspondence, ensuring they are dealt with efficiently, effectively and appropriately.
- 3) Collaborate with club development officers to ensure high-quality training and competition opportunities are available throughout the Talent Development pathway.
- 4) Establish performance benchmarks and relevant testing protocols for Canoeing Ireland development athletes to ensure they are prepared for future competitive canoe sprint environments.
- 5) Prepare accurate reports on Canoeing Ireland development athletes' performances against benchmarks when required.
- 6) Maintain accurate Talent Pathway athlete performance records and liaise with club coaches, personal coaches and parents where required.
- 7) Provide support for club development officers and coaches as required.
- 8) Ensure that 'Safe Practices' are maintained at all-times in line with Canoeing Ireland Safeguarding policies.
